3. AWARD CRITERA

SCI is committed to running a fair and transparent tender process and ensuring that all bidders are treated and assessed equally during this tender process. Bidder responses will be evaluated against four weighted categories of criteria: Essential Criteria, Sustainability Criteria, Capability Criteria, and Commercial Criteria.

3.1 ESSENTIAL CRITERIA

Criteria which bidders **must** meet in order to progress to the next round of evaluation. If a bidder does not meet any of the Essential Criteria, they will be excluded from the tender process immediately. These criteria are scored as 'Pass' / 'Fail'.

3.2 SUSTAINABILITY CRITERIA (10%)

Criteria used to evaluate the impact a supplier has on the environment, local economy and community. Bids will be evaluated against the same pre-agreed Criteria.

3.3 CAPABILITY CRITERIA (40%)

Criteria used to evaluate the bidder's ability, skill and experience in relation to the requirements. Bids will be evaluated against the same pre-agreed Criteria.

3.4 COMMERIAL CRITERIA (50%)

Criteria used to evaluate the commercial competitiveness of a bid. Bids will be evaluated against the same pre-agreed Criteria.

4. VETTING

Successful bidders must be successfully vetted. This involves checking bidders and key personnel against Global Watch Lists, Enhanced Due Diligence Lists and Politically Exposed Persons Lists.

The vetting of bidders will be completed after the award decision and prior to any contract being signed, or orders placed. If any information provided by the Bidder throughout the



tender process is proved to be incorrect during the vetting process (or at any other point), SCI may withdraw their award decision.

Bidders wishing to submit a bid **must use the Bidder Response Document template in** Part 3 **of this Tender Pack**. Any bids received using different formats, or incomplete bids, will not be accepted.

This document allows bidders to submit all the required information and be evaluated fairly and equally against the Essential, Capability and Commercial Criteria. Bidders may also be required to submit supporting documentation. Further instructions can be found within the document in Part 3 of this pack.

<u>Bids must be split as technical offer (Essential, Sustainability & Capability) &</u> Financial offer (Commercial Criteria) by Electronic or Paper submission as below:

The Bidder is required to sign a copy of the Check list in Section 4 as part of their submission.

2. INSTRUCTIONS

Within each section there are instructions providing guidance to the bidder on what information is required. This guidance details the <u>MINIMUM</u> requirements expected by SCI. If a Bidder wishes to add further information, this is acceptable, but the additional information should be limited to only items that are relevant to the tender.

- For the avoidance of doubt, bidders are required to complete all items within the Bidder Response Document unless clear instruction is provided otherwise.
- ➤ If a Bidder does not complete the entire Bidder Response document, their submission may be declared void.
- ➤ If a Bidder is unable to complete any element of the Bidder Response Document, they should contact Save the Children through the using the contact details provided for guidance. **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**
- ➤ Bidders who pass the essential criteria will be eligible for further evaluation and sample check.
- ➤ Bidders who fail to submit all required documents will be given 48 hours to re-share the missing documents. Otherwise, they will be considered as ineligible.



- ➤ Bidders who fail some items in the sample evaluation stage will be given 48 hours to replace sample and provide alternative; without changing the price offered in the financial proposal.
- ➤ If necessary, SCI may conduct supplier visit before contracting for assessing quality, compliance with regulations, and capacity and capability assessment.
- ➤ The contractual timeframe of the FWA is for one years, with possibility of amendment in terms of items or price every 6 months. This is subject to market analysis and both parties for the contract must agree.
- > Contractual currency is in **EGP**.
- > Payment will be in bank cheque or bank transfer, after delivery and within 15 days from submitting the invoice.
- Section 3 evaluation is based on best value for money.

By submitting a response, the bidder confirms that all information provided can be relied upon for validity and accuracy.
